<p><b>Objective</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To learn the sequences of the scale of G on the Jumbie Jam Steel Pan.</li> <li>To learn to play the first notes of Tune One – Day O, "<a href="#">The Banana Boat Song</a>".</li> </ul>	<p><a href="#"><u><i>Andy Gleadhill's Caribbean Steel Pan Book.</i></u></a></p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will be able to play the sequences of the scale of G on the Jumbie Jam Steel Pans.</li> <li>Students will play together the opening notes of Tune One – Day O, "<a href="#">The Banana Boat Song</a>". <p><b>Warm-up and Starter</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>From now on lessons can begin with warm-up exercises 1a, 1b, 1c and the repeat after me exercises.</li> </ul>	<p><i>Chapter 6: Warm-up and Practise Exercises; Exercise 1, 1a, 1b, 1c, Repeat After Me.</i></p>
<p><b>Main Activity</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explain how the sequences work with the scale of G on the Jumbie Jam Steel Pans.</li> <li>Begin to play the sequences using the scale of G on the Jumbie Jam Steel Pans.</li> </ul>	<p><i>Chapter 6: Warm-up and Practise Exercises; Sequences.</i></p>
<p><b>Secondary Activity</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Begin to learn the unison section of Tune One – Day O, "<a href="#">The Banana Boat Song</a>". [<a href="#">Video</a>]</li> </ul>	<p><i>Chapter 13: Six Tunes; Tune One – Day O, "<a href="#">The Banana Boat Song</a>".</i></p>
<p><b>Plenary</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What went well?</li> <li>What can be done better next time?</li> <li>Ask the students to agree on what went well and what needs to be worked upon.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Performance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Help the students to begin to construct a performance of the arpeggios and sequences of the scale of G.</li> </ul>
